January 8th	<i>AGM + New Year Drinks & Nibbles</i> External Speaker: Tim Turner , Senior Valuer at Sworders Fine Art Auctioneers, giving a talk about antiques, incorporating a mini- 'Antiques Roadshow'.
March 12th	External Speaker: Anthea Hawdon , of Raking Light, with a presentation about her work on historic graffiti, which features several of our local churches. 'Raking Light' is a technique that sheds light obliquely across surfaces, revealing details that are not readily apparent.
May 14th	External Speaker: Sarah-Joy Maddeaux , Sound Archivist at the Essex Record Office, giving a talk entitled 'How to Speak Essex', about Essex accents as recorded in the Essex Sound and Video Archive.

Using local newspaper reports, Darren and Maggie will look at the original show (1855-1933), and Alf will talk about the modern show, revived in 1990.
