How to Speak Essex

A Talk by the Sound Archivist at the Essex Record Office

Do you have an Essex accent? Is the Essex accent dying out?
This talk will look at the variety of ways of speaking in our county over the last hundred years, including dialect (the words used) and accent (the way words are pronounced).

Illustrated by recordings from the Essex Sound and Video Archive dating back to the early twentieth century, we will discover that there has never been just one 'Essex accent', no 'right' or 'wrong' way of speaking.
