## GENERAL MEETING DATES:

All **Tuesday** evenings, at The Three Horseshoes, Duton Hill (in the Upstairs Meeting Room), starting at **7.45 p.m. for 8.00 p.m.**

<b>January 8<sup>th</sup></b>	AGM + New Year Drinks & Nibbles External Speaker: <b>Tim Turner</b> , Senior Valuer at Sworders Fine Art Auctioneers, giving a talk about antiques, incorporating a mini- 'Antiques Roadshow'.
<b>March 12<sup>th</sup></b>	External Speaker: <b>Anthea Hawdon</b> , of Raking Light, with a presentation about her work on historic graffiti, which features several of our local churches. 'Raking Light' is a technique that sheds light obliquely across surfaces, revealing details that are not readily apparent.
<b>May 14<sup>th</sup></b>	External Speaker: <b>Sarah-Joy Maddeaux</b> , Sound Archivist at the Essex Record Office, giving a talk entitled 'How to Speak Essex', about Essex accents as recorded in the Essex Sound and Video Archive.
<b>July 9<sup>th</sup></b>	A presentation by TALHG Members <b>Darren Stone, Maggie Stevens and Alf Wright</b> – "Read all about... The Countess of Warwick's Cottage Garden Show".
